Re: By-law No. 667-09

In keeping with earlier communication and recent Public Announcements, effective **May 1, 2009**, the Town of Niverville moves forward to implement By-law No. 667-09 ... its new Waste Management System.

Following the example of several other municipalities, businesses, institutions and apartments will **no** longer be included in the Town's waste collection and removal process. This new direction moves Niverville closer to an effective and environmentally responsible waste management system. Strong emphasis is being placed on recycling with Council committed to augmenting this service in 2009.

It is acknowledge that this is a significant change. Adjustments and different approaches in weekly removal of waste will be considered ... from doing one self ... to joint sharing of bins ... to hiring an outside firm. Should you be interest in hiring private waste collection services, there are a number of companies in the region including two local businesses which specialize in this service – namely, Valley Disposal (Cliff Harder – 392-6677) and Bristol Hauling (Willi Toews – 371-0268). Representatives from these firms would be pleased to answer any questions you may have.

Please note the following:

1. There will be no special waste collection or disposal tax levy assessed by any properties that have been removed from the system.
2. Recycling services will continue to be provided to all businesses, apartments and institutions.
