TOWN OF NIVERVILLE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL PESTICIDE PROGRAM

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2019:

1. To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public reserves and parks within the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M. The program will run from May 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019 using a ground sprayer.
2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitoes, the Town may use larvacide using Aquabac 200g.

This program will commence from May 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of those of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.

The public may send written submissions or objections within 15 days of the publication of the notice to the department below:

Pet Reminders

Licenses: Licenses are \$20 per pet, per year and up-to-date rabies and distemper information must be presented at the time of licensing.

First time licenses are \$20, if you renew your license on or before your due date there is a reduced fee of just \$15 per pet.

In the event that your animal is picked up by Animal Control, you will be charged a fee of \$200 for first time impoundment. Should your pet be unlicensed or has a past due license at the time of impoundment, the license will be \$100.

Dog Park: A friendly reminder as per Niverville Animal Control Bylaw 691-10, the only authorized public off-leash dog area is at the Niverville Dog Park, located behind the Niverville Centennial Arena. This park was developed specifically for your pets' enjoyment! All other public parks in Niverville require pets to be on leash and under the control of their owners at all times.

Clean up: Going for a walk with your dog? Remember it is the pet owner's responsibility to pick up their pet's "treasures". Please help to keep our community clean!
