## WATER CURB STOP REMINDER

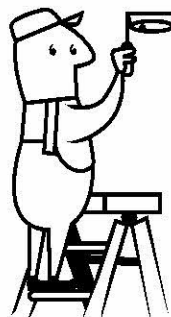


If you live in Fifth Avenue Estates or the Crow Wing Development, please note that it is a requirement that the potable water curb stop valve is installed and maintained at ground level, clearly marked and readily accessible. In the event the Town is required to look for and make any necessary repairs to the potable water curb stop to meet the above noted requirements, the cost incurred to bring into compliance is the homeowner's responsibility and an amount owing to the municipality. It may be collected in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under The Municipal Act. Your attention to this matter now will facilitate any future emergency repairs.
