On Friday, October 14th our Annual Fall Food Drive in Niverville

held another success! This year, Niverville Youth Groups collected over **3,638 non-perishable items and \$345!** That is over 270 items more than last year. 3,638 non-perishables can feed approximately 182 families for one week, that's a lot of food.

We would like to thank the many people who helped make this event such a success: Niverville Youth Groups, the churches of Niverville, Niverville Helping Hands Volunteers and volunteer community members. And of course the generous people of Niverville!

For those of you who have children in Niverville Elementary and Collegiate, you may have heard or been a part of Farm Credit Canada's "Drive Away Hunger" campaign. The kids were asked to fill paper bags with non-perishables which were donated to our food bank. Together with New Bothwell Elementary, Puratone, Niverville Elementary and Collegiate, **2,702 pounds of nonperishables** were collected and donated to our food bank. Niverville currently has 20 licensed EMR and PCP members. Our service is First Responders only; this means we do not transport patients to hospital.
