PUBLIC NOTICE

General Borrowing By-Law 832-21

Public Hearing

Public Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 169(6) of *The Municipal Act* that the Council of the Town of Niverville will hold a Virtual Public Hearing on the **11th day of May 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** to present its proposal to borrow \$4,000,000.00 to pay for:

Construction of an Expanded Water Treatment Plant at Spruce Drive

The total estimated cost of the Water Treatment Plant is \$10,000,000.00, to be funded as follows:

\$3,250,000.00 has been secured from the Province of Manitoba Water Services Board; and Intend to secure an additional \$1,750,000.00 from the Province of Manitoba Water Services Board; and \$1,000,000.00 from the Town of Niverville Water Utility Reserve Fund.

The balance of \$4,000,000.00 to be funded by borrowing.

The borrowing will be repaid over 20 years at a maximum interest rate of 6% per year.

The annual repayment amount will be no more than \$348,738.23 to be funded by revenues from capital development fees/connection fees from new construction, which may be reduced by the application of annual Federal Gas Tax Revenues. There are no additional taxes arising as a result of this project.

Individuals who would like to attend the virtual meeting must register in advance by emailing planning@wheretheyoubelong.ca **on or before May 10, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.** Instructions for joining the meeting will be forwarded upon confirming your attendance. If you would like to attend but do not have electronic means or internet access, please call the office 204-388-4600 and staff will make alternate arrangements.

Council will hear any person who would like to make a presentation, ask questions, or register an objection to the proposal as provided. As an alternative to attending the public hearing, residents may send their opinions in advance to the Town at planning@wheretheyoubelong.ca. If you have questions on the proposal, please send them in advance so that a response can be provided prior to the hearing.
