

WHEREAS that the Town of Niverville is fortunate enough to have a significant commercial and economic development opportunity in front of them;
AND WHEREAS this development represents approximately \$25 million in private investment into Niverville and the Province of Manitoba;
AND WHEREAS this development is proposing \$10 million of foreign international investment into the Provincial Economy;
THEREFORE in recognition of no current cost-sharing programs in effect for Manitoba municipalities to apply to Manitoba Infrastructure for Provincial Road improvements;
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Niverville is requesting that the Province of Manitoba find a method to fund the proposed signalized intersection at Mulberry and PR311 at a one-third partnership in order to assist in the continued economic development of the Province of Manitoba.
