Proposal: Conditional Use: To allow for a retail automotive service and sales business and

two 2 ft. by 10 ft. freestanding advertising flags in an Industrial Mixed Use Zone

(MM).

## Variance:

- 1. To vary the requirement for a vehicle entrance and exit of 20 ft. each for an auto-oriented business to one combined vehicle entrance and exit of 50 ft.
- 2. To allow for up to 3 identification signs for this use, to an aggregate maximum of 348 sq ft. with signs to be located on the north, east, and west side of the building.
- 3. To vary the required parking stalls from 15 to 11.
- 4. To vary the minimum driving isle width from 24ft to 18.5ft.
