Recyclable materials pickup is bi-weekly.
 For reference purposes, the collection schedule and zones are posted on the Town's website whereyoubelong.ca

On Collection Day these regulations must be followed:

PREPARE IT All acceptable recyclable materials must fit into the container and the lid MUST close or the recycling cart will not be emptied. NO EXTRA MATERIAL WILL BE COLLECTED. Do not jam or pack items into your cart. Items must fall freely from the cart into the truck.

PLACE IT Place your cart on the street with the wheels against the curb, with **at least 3 feet of clearance** between the cart and any obstacles. If you do not have a curb, place just off the roadway on the shoulder. **Carts MUST be out by 8:00 a.m. on your collection day.**

PARK IT By 11:59 p.m. on your collection day, your cart must be removed from the street and returned to its storage location near your building.

- Tetra Pak Juice Boxes & Milk Cartons



- Plastic Shopping Bags
- Styrofoam
- Trash
- Glass Cookware
- Ceramics (cups/plates)
- Food Scraps
- Motor Oil Containers/Filters

- Clothing and Textiles
