2021 Financial Plan Public Hearing

Public Notice is hereby given pursuant to subsection 162(2) of The Municipal Act that the Council of the Town of Niverville intends to present its financial plan for the fiscal year 2021 at a virtual Public Hearing Centre on the **20th of April, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.** Individuals who would like to attend the virtual meeting must register in advance by emailing planning@whereyoubelong.ca on or before **April 19, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.** Instructions for joining the meeting will be forwarded upon confirming your attendance. If you would like to attend but do not have electronic means or internet access, please call the office 204-388-4600 and staff will make alternate arrangements.

Council will hear any person who would like to make a presentation, ask questions or register an objection to the financial plan as provided. **As an alternative to attending the public hearing, residents may send their opinions in advance to the Town at planning@whereyoubelong.ca.** If you have questions on the financial plan, please send them in advance so that a response can be provided prior to the hearing.

TOWN OF NIVERVILLE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL PESTICIDE PROGRAM

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2021:

1. To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public reserves and parks within the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M. The program will run from May 1, 2021 to October 31, 2021 using a ground sprayer.
2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitoes, the Town may larvicide using Aquabac 200g.

This program will commence from May 1, 2021 to October 31, 2021.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.

ANNUAL PUBLIC NOTICE

Additions to the Voters List and/or Personal Security Protection Requests

In accordance with Section 36 of The Municipal Councils and School Board Elections Act (MCSBEA), the Town of Niverville Voters List is open for changes or revisions.

- Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the Local Authority of the Town of Niverville can have his or her name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the voter in the Voters List corrected.
- Any person can request to have his or her name and address obscured from the Voters List.

A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. In a vote on a question, that person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.

To implement the above, a written request including name and address along with proof of identity must be submitted to the Senior Election Official in person, by e-mail, fax or mail to:
