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PUBLIC NOTICE General Borrowing By-Law 832-21 Public Hearing

Public Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 169(6) of *The Municipal Act* that the Council of the Town of Niverville will hold a Virtual Public Hearing on the **11th day of May 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** to present its proposal to borrow \$4,000.000.00 to pay for:

Construction of an Expanded Water Treatment Plant at Spruce Drive

The total estimated cost of the Water Treatment Plant is \$10,000,000.00, to be funded as follows: \$3,250,000.00 has been secured from the Province of Manitoba Water Services Board; and Intend to secure an additional \$1,750,000.00 from the Province of Manitoba Water Services Board; and \$1,000,000.00 from the Town of Niverville Water Utility Reserve Fund.

The balance of \$4,000,000.00 to be funded by borrowing.

The borrowing will be repaid over 20 years at a maximum interest rate of 6% per year.

The annual repayment amount will be no more than \$348,738.23 to be funded by revenues from capital development fees/connection fees from new construction, which may be reduced by the application of annual Federal Gas Tax Revenues. There are no additional taxes arising as a result of this project.

Individuals who would like to attend the virtual meeting must register in advance by emailing planning@whereyoubelong.ca on or before May 10, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. Instructions for joining the meeting will be forwarded upon confirming your attendance. If you would like to attend but do not have electronic means or internet access, please call the office 204-388-4600 and staff will make alternate arrangements.

Council will hear any person who would like to make a presentation, ask questions, or register an objection to the proposal as provided. As an alternative to attending the public hearing, residents may send their opinions in advance to the Town at planning@whereyoubelong.ca. If you have questions on the proposal, please send them in advance so that a response can be provided prior to the hearing.

WATER RESTRICTIONS

As per Bylaw 797-18, Niverville's Operations Manager is declaring a **Stage 2 Outdoor Water Use Restriction** effective **May 1, 2021, applicable to all those on the municipal water system.**

Under Stage 2, residents must limit lawn watering to even numbered days for residents having even numbered civic addresses and residents having odd numbered civic addresses to limit watering of lawns to odd numbered days. Residents are also encouraged to use water wisely by watering when the least amount of evaporation occurs. Stage 2 allows for watering of new grass plantings - sod within 21 days and seed within 45 days of installation, subject to reasonable evidence of recent installation.

Persons not complying with water restrictions are subject to penalties as enforced by a Town Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Sidewalk Upgrades. Starting on May 3, 2021 selected sidewalks around Niverville will be repaired starting at Main Street between Prairie Trail and 2nd Avenue North. Residents are advised that during construction, there will be no access to the sidewalk along that stretch.



Shoulder Extension at Drover's Run. This roadwork is currently in progress and will improve access/egress for local traffic and delivery vehicles. Traffic may be down to one lane at times. Please exercise caution when passing workers and construction equipment.
