

OPERATIONS UPDATE

Park Lighting - Town work crews continue to install additional lighting in Hespeler Park along the length of the walking path south to Crown Valley Road. Piles for the new park lighting have been installed. The Town will be trenching in the wire in the next couple of weeks. Please be mindful to stay on the paved path at all times in that area.



Community Resource & Recreation Centre Parking Lot - The latest step in construction for the CRRC is parking lot completion. As paving has begun and crews are in the area, residents are asked to please proceed with caution and remain outside the fenced-in area.

NEW RESIDENTS' TEMPORARY RECYCLING PROCEDURES

Moving into Town and need a recycling bin? The Town has placed an order for bins and they should arrive by end of July 31, 2021. Please contact the Town Office to register to receive your bin. Until the new bins arrive, new residents should place their recycling in blue bags at the end of their driveway (on opposite side of the garbage bin if possible). Once bins have been provided, blue bags will no longer be accepted.

This is a temporary measure for properties without recycling bins. Residents with existing bins are reminded any recycling placed outside of the recycling bin will not be picked up.

CROW WING TRAIL & WALKING PATHS

Did you know Niverville has many well-maintained walking paths to explore? The Crow Wing Trail connecting Winnipeg and Emerson runs directly through the Town of Niverville. This historic trail guides you through the wetlands pavilion area. This section of Town is rich in nature and is open to the public to enjoy.

There is also a self-guided tour along Main Street to read about the history of the area. Check out the six plaques beginning near Chicken Chef and continuing east toward the credit union, post office, and more. Heritage signs are also located on the elementary school fence.
