WHEREAS the Province of Manitoba has passed but not yet proclaimed Bill 37 which will in part create the Capital Planning Region (CPR) encompassing 18 municipalities including the Town of Niverville and require the CPR to adopt a regional land use plan;

AND WHEREAS the Winnipeg Metropolitan Region (WMR) has prepared and submitted a regional land use plan titled Focus 20-50 to the Province for consideration as the Regional Plan

AND WHEREAS the Plan is the vision of consultants and is not representative of the vision of the WMR members all of which will be part of the CPR; AND WHEREAS a number of future members of the CPR wish to join together to express their concerns to the Province with respect to both Bill 37 and the Focus 20-50 Plan;

AND WHEREAS these municipalities are proposing to retain the services of a communications consultant to assist with the preparation and execution of a communication strategy to express their concerns to the Province of Manitoba, the WMR and/or the CPR, and to residents of their respective municipalities; THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of Niverville does hereby support this initiative and authorizes funding on an equal basis to a maximum of \$5,000.00 for the costs of retaining a Communication Consultant to develop and implement a communication strategy as set out above subject to confirmation of the estimated cost based on the number of participating municipalities.
