**Internet banking:** Available through most financial institutions. To ensure electronic payments will not be subject to a late penalty, please allow at least 3 business days for bank processing.

**Drop box:** Located at the front of the Town Office at 329 Bronstone Drive. The drop box is checked Monday to Friday and at 5 p.m. on the due date. **Payments dropped off after 5 p.m. on September 29, 2022 will be considered late and will be subject to a penalty.** Please make cheque or money order payable to the Town of Niverville.

## SEWER CLEANING-SEPTEMBER

Sewer cleaning will be taking place in September with dates to be announced once confirmed.

Occasionally during sewer cleaning, air pressure builds in the sewer line causing water to splash out of toilets, sinks and drains. Please take the following precautions to prevent water damage in your home:

- Close lids and cover toilet bowls when not in use.
- Insert drain plugs in all sinks and bathtubs when not in use.
- Remove all floor mats in bathrooms.
- Place an old towel around base of toilets.
- Cover all basement floor drains.

Sewer cleaning on rare occasions may leave an odor in the home. If so, please run some water down all sink and bathtub drains, flush toilets, pour a pail of water into each basement floor drain and open your windows. After a short time the odour should go away.
