Voting Place

Voting place will be open for voting on **October 26, 2022** between **8:00 a.m.** and **8:00 p.m.** at the Golden Friendship Centre, 118 2nd Avenue South, Niverville.

Identification may be required before being allowed to vote. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example—driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

An eligible voter whose name is not on the voters list is entitled to be added to the list at the time of voting, as long as they attend the voting place where they are qualified to vote, during the hours it is open for voting, they take an oath that they are an eligible voter, and they establish their identity.

Advance Voting

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they may be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the Golden Friendship Centre, 118 2nd Avenue South, Niverville on Wednesday, **October 12, 2022** between **8:00 a.m.** and **8:00 p.m.**

Mobile Voting

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside in a personal care facility or assisted living facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following facilities on **October 17, 2022**:

Application to vote by sealed envelope

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person or in writing to the Senior Election Official at the Niverville Administration Office, 329 Bronstone Drive, Box 267, Niverville Manitoba, R0A 1E0, by fax at (204) 388-6110 or by email to audrey.neufeld@whereyoubelong.ca.

If applying in person, a voter may apply between **September 28, 2022** and **October 23, 2022**. A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by mail, fax or email, a voter may apply between **July 28, 2022** and **October 23, 2022**. A voter applying by mail, fax or email will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the Senior Election Official.

Property Tax Reminder

This is a reminder to residents that property taxes are due on September 29, 2022 by 5:00 pm. If no tax bill has been received, property owners are responsible for contacting the Town Administration office to request a copy, and remit payment by the stated due date, regardless of whether or not a tax notice is in their name (for new property owners). Email taxes@whereyoubelong.ca or call 204-388-4600 ext.1201 to request a copy or enquire about your bill.

All tax payments must be received in the Town Office by 5 p.m. on the due date. Cheques may be post-dated to the due date (Sept. 29, 2022) but must be received by the Town Office by 5 p.m. on this date or they will be considered late and will be subject to a penalty of 1.25% per month (compounded annually).

However, an eligible voter whose name is not on the voters list is entitled to be added to the list at the time of voting, as long as they attend the voting place where they are qualified to vote, during the hours it is open for voting, they take an oath that they are an eligible voter, and they establish their identity.



Storing Recreational Vehicles



With camping season soon approaching its end, residents are reminded that between November 1st and April 30th of the following year, it is not permitted to park or store a recreational vehicle, motor home or travel trailer on a driveway in the front yard of a property or on Town road allowance.

Parking on side or rear yards is permitted, subject to the vehicle being placed on a hard surface (asphalt, concrete or gravel parking pad). Bylaw 795-18 Section 3.18, as amended.

Construction Updates

The 2022 Road Repairs have begun. Main repairs include sections of Lilac Place, 4th Street South, Hampton Drive, Cobblestone Court, Lytham Place, and asphalt path work along Drover's Run.

Street crack sealing is planned to begin on the week of September 26th. Areas include the Highlands, 5th Avenue Estates West, and the south half of 5th Avenue Estates East.
