Recycling is picked up on a bi-weekly basis. To identify whether you are in the blue zone or the green zone for waste and recycling pick-up, please check the Town website at www.wheretheyoubelong.ca for the Recycling Map.

On Collection Day these regulations must be followed:

PREPARE IT All acceptable recyclable materials must fit into the container and the lid **MUST** close or the recycling cart will not be emptied. **NO EXTRA MATERIAL WILL BE COLLECTED.** Do not jam or pack items into your cart. Items must fall freely from the cart into the truck.

PLACE IT Place your cart on the street with the wheels against the curb, with **at least 3 feet of clearance** between the cart and any obstacles. If you do not have a curb, place just off the roadway on the shoulder. **Carts MUST be out by 8:00 a.m. on your collection day.**

PARK IT By 11:59 p.m. on your collection day, your cart must be removed from the street and returned to its storage location near your building.

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Office Paper

- Cardboard (please flatten boxes)
- Paperboard
- Paper Bags
- Wrapping Paper



- Plastic Shopping Bags
- Styrofoam
- Trash
- Glass Cookware
- Ceramics (cups/plates)
- Food Scraps
- Motor Oil Containers/Filters*
- Yard Waste
- Garden Hoses
- Clothing and Textiles
- Light Bulbs
- Electronics
- Human or Animal Waste (including dirty diapers)
- Paper Plates & Napkins
- Plastics #3, #4, and #6
- Any containers that carry this symbol >
- Hazardous and industrial waste (including cooking oil)



PLASTIC

- Plastic types #1, #2, #5, and #7
- Water and Soda Bottles
- Milk Jugs
- Detergent Bottles



OTHER

- Glass Bottles and Jars (no broken glass)
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin and Steel Cans
- Tetra Pak Juice Boxes & Milk Cartons
