

Town of Niverville 2023 Planning Session Highlights December 5th, 2022

Last weekend Town Council and staff met at the Town Office to plan what the next year holds for the Town of Niverville. All aspects of the municipal realm were discussed and by the end of the weekend, a preliminary budget was presented to Council.

Some key items coming out of planning session and the preliminary budget for the Town in the coming year are:

- Send out a Request for Proposal for a new Water Tanker for the Niverville Fire & Emergency Service
- ➤ Send out a Request for Proposal to undertake the complete overhaul of the road, sewer, sidewalks and drainage along 4th Avenue South between 1st & 3rd Streets South.
- Undertaking the modernization and accessibility improvements of the lobby & washrooms of the Centennial Arena
- Completion of the Bollard art project in front of the Niverville CRRC.
- Increasing the Town's tree budget for planting and maintenance.
- The Town will continue to assist & lead in the development of four parks within the community: Opa's Park, Station Park (Phase 2), Grant Park & completion of the Dog Park expansion
- Completion of the RCMP detachment in Niverville with anticipation of new members being positioned.
- The Town will work towards completing the Pre-Design of PR311 between Wallace & Krahn in the new year and anticipate that detailed design should begin late in 2023.
- The Town will be making application to the Province to potentially add two new crosswalks on 5th Avenue South in 2023: the first by Hampton North and the second by Hespeler Park Drive.

Town staff & Council worked on some strategic objectives that will be coming up in the next five years including: having the expanded Water Treatment Plant come online in 2023, the anticipated need for additional space for the Fire Department and Operations (2024 – 2026), development of a dedicated



library program and additional daycare space (2026 – 2028) and completion of the Wastewater Treatment Facility (2027).

Through Niverville Health Care Services Inc. the Town has been proud to see new doctors join the team in 2022 and look forward to more announcements of more doctors in 2023. In addition, the expanded Saturday offerings are a step towards being able to provide same-day / next-day care to more members of our community.
