Town of Niverville Proposed Municipal Pesticide Program

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2023:

1. To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public reserves and parks within the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M. The program will run from May 1, 2023 to October 31, 2023 using a ground sprayer.
2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitos, the Town may larvicide using Aquabac 200g.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.
