Spring Thaw Preventative Maintenance Tips

Spring is just around the corner and the annual snow melt means there is potential for water to enter basements from unsealed openings in basement walls or from basement windows. Here are some tips for residents to help mitigate the risk of water entering their home:



- Clear the snow away from your foundation.
- Identify and seal any gaps between basement walls and framing around windows and doors, cables, pipes, etc.
- Maintain eavestroughs and downspouts by cleaning them regularly to ensure they are not clogged with debris. This will be especially important when there is rainfall during spring.
- Ensure sump pumps or backwater valves are operating properly.
- Remove all valuables and belongings from at-risk areas in the home to avoid potential damage, or avoid storing items directly on the basement floor.
- Have an emergency plan in place in case there is ever a need to evacuate your home due to overland flooding.
