TOWN OF NIVERVILLE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL PESTICIDE PROGRAM

Public Notice is hereby given that the Town of Niverville intends to conduct the following Pesticide Control Program during 2024:

- 1.To control noxious weeds on road allowances, public preserves and parks within the municipality, the Town may use the herbicides Fiesta, Round Up, 2-4-D Amine 600, and Curtail M. The Program will run from May 1st, 2024 to October 31st, 2024 using a ground sprayer.
- 2. To control populations of nuisance mosquitos, the Town may larvicide using Aquabac 200g.

This Program will commence from May 1st, 2024 to October 31st, 2024.

All pesticides and procedures applied will be in accordance with federal laws and recommendations of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture.

A travel health consultation is a personalized consultation with Dr. Chris Burnett, who has a passion for travel and is ITSM certified.

Once your initial consultation is booked, the clinic will send you a questionnaire that will help Dr. Burnett personalize his advice specifically to your needs.

During the consultation Dr. Burnett will discuss:

- Recommended and mandatory vaccines
- How to identify and reduce potential health risks
- Potential illnesses you may be exposed to
- How your current and past medical history may affect your trip.
- And more!

At the conclusion of your appointment, you will receive an electronic handout outlining the details discussed during your consultation.

What to bring to your appointment?

- Your Manitoba Health Card
- All your current medication (not just a list)
- Copy of your travel itinerary

Please try and arrive 10 minutes before your appointment time. You should allow for 30-45 minutes for your appointment.
