I will adhere to all provisions of By-law No. 864-24 and amendments thereto and any further conditions set out below. I understand that if I should fail to do all the I have herein undertaken and the fire escapes the approved location, I may be responsible for all costs incurred by the Town of Niverville in fighting the fire, and any losses arising therefrom to public or private property.

I understand that the Niverville Fire Chief or any Designated Employee may revoke or suspend this Permit upon giving such a notice and opportunity to appeal the revocation or suspension if the Niverville Fire Chief or Designated Employee believes that I have contravened any of the conditions of the Permit, the provisions of By-law 864-24, or any provision of the Manitoba Fire Code or where conditions make the permitted activity unsafe.

I understand that this Permit is non-transferable and is valid only for the type of fire, and location and date noted above.

Rules regarding all Open-Air Fires

A person in charge of an open-air fire must ensure that:

- a) The fire is always supervised by a person 18 years of age or older until it is fully extinguished;
- b) The fire is always kept under control;
- c) An adequate supply of water, sand or some other means of controlling and extinguishing the fire is readily accessible;
- d) The fire is not set or maintained in conditions or locations which will or could result in:
 - smoke which causes nuisance to adjacent properties;
 - reduced visibility on any highway or road;
 - a rapid spread of fire through grass or brushed area;
- e) The fire is not set or maintained when the wind exceeds 32 kilometers per hour;
- f) If the fire becomes uncontrollable or spreads beyond its assigned limits, the Niverville Fire and Emergency Services is alerted by calling 911;
- g) The fire is maintained within an approved receptacle;
- h) The fire is maintained a minimum of 3 meters (10 feet), as measured from the nearest edge of the fire, from any combustible building or structures, combustible fences, trees or overhead wires;
- i) Only clean, dry, unpainted, and untreated wood is burned and no grass, leaves, brush or tree pruning materials are burned in the fire; and
- j) Burn barrels and burning of garbage and rubbish is prohibited.
