## **Prime Location**

Strategically located in Manitoba's beautiful southeastern region, our town is only 20 minutes away from Winnipeg's South Perimeter (between Highways 59 & 75 on Provincial Road 311) and just 25 minutes from Steinbach.

We boast a prime location: a short driving distance of 47.5 km/29.5 miles to the Winnipeg Richardson International Airport and 83 km/51.6 miles to the US Border. It's just one of the many factors contributing to our town's rapid growth rate.

# **Fastest-Growing Community**

With a growing population of 6,000, the region Niverville serves is home to more than **33,000** people (including the area within a 20-minute drive). We are proud of the recognition we received in 2021 when Niverville was named the fastest-growing community in Manitoba and the 5th-fastest in Canada.

New residents are attracted to the charm of small-town living with a short drive to either of the two larger neighbouring cities, Winnipeg and Steinbach. Our residential growth aligns with our goal of supporting commercial and institutional facilities — and attracting visitors from smaller surrounding communities.

All the services and amenities necessary to support your business and workforce are here — no need for you or your employees to commute.

Thanks to our leaders, Niverville is growing to become a hub in Southern Manitoba. ## Niverville Recreation & Wellness

Home to one of the province's premier sports and recreation venues, Niverville is quickly becoming the "go-to" place for provincial sports tournaments. This is all thanks to the Community Resource and Recreation Centre. Opened in 2021, the Niverville CRRC is home to a regulation-sized hockey rink, a full-sized fieldhouse designed for a multitude of international regulation sports, and a number of multipurpose rooms capable of hosting events of any size. Just beside the CRRC is another community rink, plus an all-natural ice surface curling rink.

Niverville Recreation and Wellness is also responsible for over 160 acres of public green space in the Town of Niverville, with its crown jewel being the 90-acre Hespeler Park. Hespeler Park is home to a splash pad, 4 baseball diamonds, and a number of soccer pitches. As well, Hespeler Park is home to the Wetlands Project, where an old municipal lagoon was converted into a beautiful recreation area and received national recognition for demonstrating environmentally sustainable leadership.

# Providence University College

The Niverville CRRC is set up to host large provincial and national sporting events. Niverville, in conjunction with Providence University College, will be hosting the 2025 Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Men's Volleyball Nationals. An event like this, which the CRRC is easily able to host, can expect about 3,000 visitors for the week. During the regular season, the Providence Pilots have approximately 275 spectators for each volleyball and basketball game.

"Making our home at the newly built CRRC has allowed the Providence Pilots to make a bigger impact in the community of Niverville and we are thrilled to continue to grow that relationship between the rapidly growing town and the Pilots. The 2025 CCAA Men's Volleyball National Championship that will be coming to Niverville next March will showcase some of the high-calibre athletes that compete for the Pilots on the volleyball court as well as top collegiate volleyball talent from across the country."

# Jette Studios Inc.

At the edge of town, you can find Jette Studios, a state-of-the-art production studio currently in its construction phase. Once finished, Jette Studios will be home to a 360 LED screen capable of producing both movie and television productions. As one of the only studios in Canada with this technology, it will bring a boon of businesses and jobs to the region once completed.

Each production will bring with it new waves of temporary workers that will require a place to stay. Currently, these workers would have to travel 25 minutes to and from Winnipeg each day. A hotel in Niverville could reliably expect to be the first stop for accommodation for these workers.






#### Population Growth Scenarios, 2026 to 2056


# 5-Year Immigration, 2016 to 2021





### Top 5 Occupations in Niverville, 2021





### Industry Revenue in Manitoba, 2022




# Current Land Usage in Niverville, 2024




# Period of Construction, 2021




## Average Value of Dwellings in Niverville, 2021

Families in Niverville are, on average, larger than the rest of Manitoba, meaning it is less likely that there are empty rooms for visitors to stay in. It also means that the likelihood is greater that external accommodation will be needed when these visitors come.



## 5 Event Venues Within 7 Minutes

Niverville is a hub of culture, events, and community in Southeastern Manitoba, consistently drawing in potential patrons to your hotel. Within a 7-minute drive of our community, you can find 5 different venues that can host a variety of events. From beautiful wedding venues to large convention centres to premier sports facilities, events of all types happen year-round in Niverville.

Each of these venues hosts on average over 60 events per year. On top of that, the Niverville Community Resource & Recreation Centre (CRRC) hosts over 15 major weekend events (tournaments, provincials, etc.) per year, plus over 65 major games. Each of Niverville's venues attracts patrons from all over the region, and will often need accommodations close by.

## **Economic Growth Strategy**

## **Council Vision 2030**

Niverville Town Council held its Visioning/Strategic Planning Session in October 2019. During the session, Town leaders identified Niverville's assets and challenges and answered this question: Where do we want to go?

A new vision for Niverville 2030 was created: "A welcoming, active, progressive, growing hub that is Where You Belong.

In this context, the town established five priority goals:

#### **GROWTH**

A community that is ready for 10,000

#### **COMMUNITY**

A welcoming, friendly community

#### **ECONOMY**

An economically sustainable community

#### **ACTIVE LVING**

Well-being of body, mind, and spirit

#### **GREEN**

An environmentally responsible community

Each goal belongs to a specific objective, reviewed annually during the Council's planning sessions. The Council commits to identifying necessary actions to achieve these goals, including appointing a person responsible for completing the steps and managing the budget required to carry out the annual operational plan.

Our Council understands that a longterm strategic plan is a living document, adapting to changing circumstances and unforeseen factors.
